What You'll Do

Field Days (3x/week)

- Assist Veterinarians on farm:
 - o Assist with **bovine herd work**, BSEs, and repro programs
 - Vaccinations
 - o Support equine appointments as needed
 - **Independently scheduled appointments on farm:**
 - o **Disbud calves**, hormone shots, vaccinations, collect samples
 - o Help with calf health, scour prevention, and dairy support
- Maintain vet packs and record treatment data

Clinic Days (2x/week)

- Answer phones, schedule calls, talk to producers
- Process payments, update records, support orders
- Run mastitis cultures, fecal analysis, and in-house lab tests
- Analyze herd data (DairyComp, DHI), prepare **ProAction materials**



Weekend Rotation

- Be available to work every 3rd Saturday morning
- Provide front desk and lab support alongside the vet on call
